These eggs are from the following the Japanese quail, Coturnix japonica, a species of Old World quail found in East Asia. They're low calorie, high protein, and filled with antioxidants. We love to boil them (they only take 5 minutes) and eat them in the car on long trips. You can put them on salads or make a Scotch egg (boil the egg, cover it in sausage, and bake it!).
